## Festival Only

- Students must be Michigan residents
- Ensembles must have at least 3 players
- The majority must be strings - violin, viola, cello, double bass, harp, and/or guitar
- Examples of ensembles include string trio, quartet, quintet, piano trio, etc.

- Students must be in grades 9-12
- Students must be Michigan residents
- Students must participate in festival in order to compete
- Ensembles must have at least 3 players
- Music must be from standard chamber literature
- Performance cannot be conducted
- Only one musician per part
- Students may participate in multiple ensembles, but must submit separate registrations for each ensemble
