Eligibility Festival Only

- Students must be in grades 7-12 and recommended by their teacher/coach.
- Students must be Michigan residents.
- Ensembles must have at least 3 players.
- The majority must be strings - violin, viola, cello double bass, harp, and/or guitar. Examples of ensembles include string trios, quartets, quintets, piano trios, etc.

Festival and Competition

- Students must be in grades 9-12.
- Students must be Michigan residents.
- Students must participate in festival in order to compete.
- ensembles must have at least 3 players.
- Music must be from standard chamber literature.
- Performance cannot be conducted
- Only one musician per part. Students may participate in multiple ensembles, but must submit separate registrations for each ensemble.
